

**Special Order No.: 23-040****Series of 2023****Reconstitution of Gender and Development (GAD) Technical Working Group****A. RATIONALE**

Gender Mainstreaming is a global strategy of making women's as well as men's concerns and experiences an integral dimension of the design, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of policies and programs in all political, economic and societal spheres so that women men benefit equality and inequality is not perpetuated. Hence, assessment of the implications of any planned interventions to women and men should be ensured in all areas and all levels of the planning cycle.

These strategies are adopted by the Philippine Government as inscribed in the following laws:

1. RA 7192 of 1992 (Women in Development and Nation Building Act).
2. Executive Order 2733 of 1995 (Approving and Adopting the Philippine Plan for Gender-Responsive Development, 1995-2025).
3. RA 9710 (Magna Carta of Women).

Magna Carta of Women cites the initial steps towards creating an enabling environment for gender mainstreaming is the establishment of a GAD database. The review and analysis of sex disaggregated data of internal and external clients are important as it serves as the basis for the formulation of GAD initiative. Also, in the same law all government agencies are required to formulate their annual gender and development plans and budgets and to submit the same to the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW).


The GAD TWG and Sub-Committee may seek assistance or representation from other Group/Unit as deemed necessary for the successful execution of the projects.
